





Through presentations to community groups as well as staff and classrooms there exists an open forum for discussion and community awareness to the ever present problems of substance abuse.












Outstanding Abilities Rewarded

Everyday practicality









Homecoming spirit fills NHS








































Team Pulls Together



A Fantastic 1988 Season






Fantastic Winning Season






SOPHOMORES
